- Visits must be scheduled 24 hours in advance through the Visit Coordinator.
- Upon arrival Visitor will phone the House for screening.
- Visitors must wear a medical procedure mask and face shield during all of the visit. Staff will provide these at the time of visit. You can re-use the face shield for following visits.
- Staff will supervise the entire visit.
- Our wonderful well-used tents will not be used any longer.
- Home-made food allowed if brought in a wipe-able container.
- Gifts should be wipe-able or in original packaging.

4. Vaccines

Many frontline staff have received the first dose during the last week of February as part of the Very High Priority group.

In preparation for vaccinations for residents, we are doing education through social stories and materials suitable for our population.

We are also obtaining consent from residents who are capable. Our RN is obtaining phone consent from Substitute Decision Makers.

Concurrently, we are asking family doctors to advise us of their recommendations related to vaccinations for our residents. We have already received replies for most residents and, so far, all of the family doctors have checked off that they recommend the vaccine for their patient.

As we collate this information, we will be in good position to send this list of residents for vaccination when roll out is open.

Attached you will also find several documents that Miae Kim, our Director of Quality, Risk and Education has put together for you regarding Vaccines.

As explained in the webinar last evening we still do not know when our residents will receive their vaccines and we are also advocating for dates for our participants and will keep you updated.
