Dining Out During Step 3 of Re-Opening Ontario – Tip Sheet for Family/Friends Sept 17, 2021

Note: Broadview Village is permitting Dining Out by fully vaccinated family/friends with fully vaccinated Residents only at this time due to the high risk situation for unvaccinated individuals and Ontario Government’s vaccine passport requirement effective September 22, 2021.

✓	If weather permits, choose outdoor dining. Risk of COVID-19 transmission is low outdoors. The COVID-19 virus generally does not like the outdoors.
✓	When choosing a restaurant consider how spread out the tables are, good ventilation/air flow, distance or travel time.
✓	Call ahead to be sure of the details (parking, hours of operation, how they ensure physical distancing, need reservation, any washroom restrictions, is there good ventilation/air flow)
✓	Plan to dine at the least busy time.
✓	Carry hand sanitizer with you at all times and use it after you are seated and again after you leave the restaurant.
✓	Ask for seating that keeps a 2 metre/6 feet physical distance between you and the next table.
✓	Keep your mask on at all times until the meal arrives on the table and you’re ready to eat.
✓	After you eat and you’re ready to leave, use hand sanitizer to put your mask back on.
